4. Entries must be submitted by Friday 11th September.
5. Entries can be hand drawn or digitally created but must be clear enough to reproduce in print and online.
6. The winning design may be adapted or refined for practical use, while keeping the spirit of the original idea.
7. By entering, the entrant and parent/carers agree that the submitted design may be used, reproduced, adapted and displayed for promotional, publicity and project purposes.
8. Personal information will only be used to administer the competition, contact the parent/carers about the entry, and arrange any prize or publicity connected with the competition. This information will not be retained by City of Lincoln Council.
9. Entries will be shortlisted by the Pride in Place Board, and the winning design will be selected by the public, through crowdsourced selection.
