City of Lincoln Council has published for inspection the City of Lincoln Council Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Draft Charging schedule. This has been prepared in accordance with the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended).

City of Lincoln Council is inviting representations on its CIL Draft Charging Schedule and associated evidence from **19th of May to 16th June 2016**. The Council is also inviting representations on the draft Regulation 123 List during the same period which sets out the types of infrastructure that the Council may fund, entirely or in part, through CIL.

Following the consultation period the City of Lincoln Council intends to submit the CIL Draft Charging Schedule for examination.

- i. that the Draft Charging Schedule has been submitted to an examiner in accordance with Section 212 of the Planning Act 2008;
- ii. publication of the recommendations of the examiner and the reasons for those recommendations, and
- iii. The approval of the charging schedule by the charging authority.
